There are two 32-bit "portable" editions of the programs: Win95/98/ME/2000/XP, as well as the full NT-version, which supports all of the above operating systems. The full NT-version of the program is quite old, and cannot be ported to 32 bit. For me it seems odd that this would be the case. If anything, Win 95/98/Me/2000 should be the way to go if you are running 32 bit OS - particularly if you want to connect to an older, non-Windows system with an x86 emulator. I'm running Win95 on my P3 machine but I have to admit that a lot of the software we use on work require the Win2000/XP versions of the software. I don't see any reason for the two 32 bit versions of the programs. When I need a new program it always seems to be 64 bit. If I had the choice I would certainly get Win2000/XP and only have 64 bit software installed. I don't think the legacy functionality should be supported for the 32 bit versions, it makes no sense. If you want to run them you will need to have a Windows 2000/XP/Vista/7 machine. 82157476af
